1924-2022
Rotary 33 Club President 1976-1977

Originally from Minnesota, Art and Jeannie moved to San Diego and co-owned the Coca-Cola Bottling company where he served as President until it was sold in 1983. Art was also Director of San Diego Trust & Savings and owned R Group Management where he worked until the office recently closed. Art and Jeannie’s unparalleled philanthropy is a true testament of their love for San Diego and the people who live in this great city. But Art and Jeannie’s true passions are the Polinsky Center, an emergency shelter for children who cannot remain at home as a result of abuse or neglect, and Promises2Kids, a non-profit organization co-founded in 1981 by Art and Jeannie under the name Child Abuse Prevention Foundation. Promises2Kids provides for the needs of thousands of foster children, such as shelter, food, and clothing, and also provides education, healthcare, and proper guidance with the aim of helping these young individuals live normal lives while under their care and to go on living productive lives when they become adults. Art lived a long, fruitful and philanthropic life, and we are far better off for knowing him in our lifetimes. He will be missed.
